**PRELIMINARY
INJUNCTION ORDER**


THIS MATTER having come before the Court for hearing on Plaintiff Fund for Jobs, Growth, and Security's motion for a preliminary injunction. Now, having reviewed Plaintiff's motion and all attendant filings, the Complaint and all exhibits, Defendants' memorandum in opposition to the motion and all attendant filings; and having heard the argument of counsel,

THE COURT FINDS that: (1) a substantial likelihood exists that Plaintiff will prevail on the merits; (2) there is a substantial threat of irreparable injury to Plaintiff if the preliminary

injunction is not issued; (3) Defendants will suffer no irreparable harm from the issuance of a preliminary injunction; and (4) the grant of a preliminary injunction is consistent with the public interest.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Defendants and their officers, agents, servants, employees or assigns are hereby enjoined until resolution of this action, or until further order of this Court, from enforcing the contribution limit contained in N.J.S.A. 19:44A-11.5, as well as any applicable rules and regulations regarding that provision, against Plaintiff.
